REMINDER: DRC CLOSING TOMORROW

CLINTON, Miss. – The Disaster Recovery Center in Yazoo County is closing at 7 p.m. tomorrow, July 19, but help will still be available.

The center is located in the Annie Ellis Elementary School, 1318 Grand Ave. in Yazoo City.

Survivors of Mississippi’s May flooding who have registered for assistance with the Federal Emergency Management Agency can call FEMA’s Helpline, **800-621-FEMA (3362)** for information.

While the deadline to register for disaster assistance has passed, those who did apply can learn the status of their request, update their contact information, respond to requests for information, and ask questions about the application process.

FEMA’s temporary housing assistance and grants for public transportation expenses, medical and dental expenses, and funeral and burial expenses do not require individuals to apply for an SBA loan. However, applicants who receive SBA loan applications must submit them to SBA loan officers to be eligible for assistance that covers personal property, vehicle repair or replacement, and moving and storage expenses.
