FOUR DISASTER RECOVERY CENTERS CLOSING

CLINTON, Miss. – Disaster Recovery Centers in Bolivar, Tunica, Warren and Wilkinson Counties are closing, but help for survivors of Mississippi’s May flooding still is available.

Survivors of the May Mississippi River flooding have until **Monday, July 11** to register for disaster aid.

The deadline has passed for survivors of the April tornadoes and storms to register for assistance. FEMA no longer will accept new requests related to those storms.

FEMA's temporary housing assistance and grants for public transportation expenses, medical and dental expenses, and funeral and burial expenses do not require individuals to apply for an SBA loan. However, applicants who receive SBA loan applications must submit them to SBA loan officers to be eligible for assistance that covers personal property, vehicle repair or replacement, and moving and storage expenses.
