### **HAZARDOUS WASTE DISPOSAL OPPORTUNITIES IN WARREN COUNTY**

**JACKSON, Miss.**—The Mississippi Department of Environmental Quality announces dates for curbside pickup of household hazardous materials for the flood impacted residents in certain areas of Warren County, including the Lake Chotard, Thompson Lake and Glass Road areas; the Highway 61 business area; and the Highway 61 South Big Black area. Household hazardous wastes are chemicals used in equipment or to maintain homes and lawns.

MDEQ staff and contractors will conduct curbside pickup of household hazardous wastes and hazardous materials in the above areas on Wednesday, July 13, Thursday, July 14 and Friday, July 15. Residents should place materials on the public road right of way on or before these dates.

Accepted wastes will include household hazardous wastes such as household chemicals, insecticides, poisons, used oil and gasoline, paint, herbicides, solvents, and also other wastes such as thermostats, lighting ballasts, computers, televisions, and cell phones.
