

**RESOLUTION LIMITING ATTENDANCE  
IN BUILDINGS, NIGHT CLUBS, COMMUNITY  
CENTERS AND OTHER ESTABLISHMENTS**

**WHEREAS**, by directive of the Center for Disease Control (CDC) and Executive Order of the Governor of the State of Mississippi, it has been recommended that no business, organization, community center or the like shall allow the congregation of ten (10) or more persons at any time during the Coronavirus COVID-19 emergency; and

**WHEREAS**, the City of Shaw has business and other facilities where attendance exceeds ten (10) or more and there is a need to enforce the ten (10) or less during the COVID-19 emergency.

**NOW THEREFORE**, be it resolved by the Mayor and Board of Alderman for the City of Shaw that no business in the City of Shaw shall allow the attendance or congregation of more than ten (10) persons until the CDC and Governor's emergency declarations are resolved or withdrawn.

Be it further resolved that this resolution shall be enforced by the City Police Department or other law enforcement agencies.
