

Building Resilient Infrastructure and Communities (BRIC) Grant Program



FY2020 Building Resilient Infrastructure and Communities Application Cycle Opened September 30, 2020! MEMA application deadline December 1, 2020.

The Building Resilient Infrastructure and Communities (BRIC) Program replaces the Pre-Disaster Mitigation (PDM) Grant Program. The Mississippi Emergency Management Agency allocation is \$600,000. The National Competition Cap is \$50,000,000. Eligible subapplicants include state agencies, local governments, and tribal governments.

All eligible applicants must have an approved Hazard Mitigation Plan at application deadline and at the time that an award is made. Subapplicants must be a participant in the National Flood Insurance Program.

Applications must be received by the Office of Mitigation no later than December 1, 2020 in order to be considered for funding under this opportunity.

Interested eligible applicants should reach out to your Hazard Mitigation Grants Specialists. Applications must be submitted and reviewed by MEMA before submittal in the FEMA GO system.
